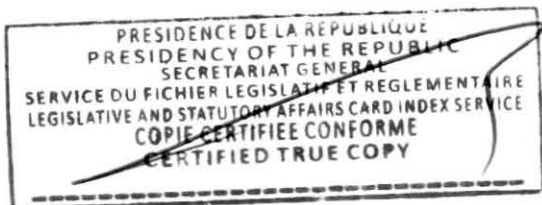


## PRESS RELEASE

The Minister of State, Secretary-General of the Presidency of the Republic hereby informs the national and international community that the **PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC, HIS EXCELLENCY Paul BIYA** has today ordered the discontinuance of proceedings pending before Military Tribunals against some officials and militants of political parties in particular the Cameroon Renaissance Movement (CRM), arrested and detained for acts committed during protests against the results of the recent presidential election.

This decision comes in the immediate aftermath of the Major National Dialogue forum convened by the **HEAD OF STATE**. It is guided by his constant resolve to promote an atmosphere of peace, fraternity and concord among the sons and daughters of Cameroon, conducive for our country's socioeconomic development.
